
Planning for Effective Integrated and Designated ELD Institute

ELEMENTARY PROGRAMS

Two-Way Bilingual/Dual Immersion

Programs: Dual language immersion integrates native English-speaking and English language learning students in the same classroom and provides academic instruction through two languages, one of which is the primary language of each group (e.g., Spanish and English). The students learn a second language while they are learning content. The goal of this program is to promote high levels of bilingualism/biliteracy in two languages.

MIDDLE SCHOOL PROGRAM

Two-Way Bilingual/Dual Immersion:

This middle school program is for both English learners (Spanish-speaking) and English-only students at the middle school level. Students interact as language models for each other in different content areas. The goal for all students is that they learn English and meet grade-appropriate academic achievement standards for grade promotion and graduation and become biliterate and multicultural scholars. The visit provides examples and models of how to grow a dual language program to the secondary level.

- **a. Heritage Language Program:** This program will showcase world language instruction in the 21st Century and how it offers high school students the opportunity to further develop and achieve communicative competence through a variety of strategies and best practices to support language acquisition and cultural competencies.
